- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 23-02.1 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to vital statistic collection; and to amend and reenact section 1-01-49 of
- 3 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the definition of father, female, male, mother, and
- 4 sex.

### 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 1-01-49 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended
7 and reenacted as follows:

#### 8 **1-01-49. Other general definitions.**

- 9 As used in this code, unless the context otherwise requires <u>or unless otherwise defined</u>:
- 10 1. "Depose" includes every mode of written statement under oath or affirmation.
- 12. "Executor" includes administrator and "administrator" includes executor.
- 12 3. <u>"Father" means a parent of the male sex.</u>
- 4. <u>"Female" means a girl, woman, or an individual whose biological reproductive system</u>
  is developed to produce ova.
- 15 <u>5.</u> "Individual" means a human being.
- 16 <u>6.</u> "Male" means a boy, man, or an individual whose biological reproductive system is
   17 <u>developed to fertilize the ova of a female.</u>
- 18 <u>7.</u> <u>"Mother" means parent of the female sex.</u>
- 19 4.8. "Oath" includes "affirmation".
- 20 <u>5.9.</u> "Organization" includes a foreign or domestic association, business trust, corporation,
- 21 enterprise, estate, joint venture, limited liability company, limited liability partnership,
- 22 limited partnership, partnership, trust, or any legal or commercial entity.
- 23 6-10. "Partnership" includes a limited liability partnership registered under chapter 45-22.
- 24 7-<u>11.</u> "Penitentiary" includes any affiliated facilities.

"Person" means an individual, organization, government, political subdivision, or 2 government agency or instrumentality. 3 <del>9.<u>13.</u></del> "Personal property" includes money, goods, chattels, things in action, and evidences 4 of debt. 5 <del>10.</del>14. "Preceding" and "following" when used by way of reference to a chapter or other part 6 of a statute means the next preceding or next following chapter or other part. 7 <del>11.</del>15. "Primary sector business" means an individual, corporation, limited liability company, 8 partnership, or association certified by the department of commerce division of 9 economic development and finance which through the employment of knowledge or 10 labor adds value to a product, process, or service which results in the creation of new 11 wealth. 12 For purposes of this subsection, "new wealth" means revenues generated by a 13 business in this state through the sale of products or services to: 14 Customers outside of this state; or a. 15 b. Customers in this state if the products or services were previously unavailable or 16 difficult to obtain from a business in this state. 17 <del>12.</del>16. "Process" means a writ or summons issued in the course of judicial proceedings. 18 <del>13.<u>17.</u></del> "Property" includes property, real and personal. 19 <del>14.</del>18. "Real property" shall be coextensive with lands, tenements, and hereditaments. 20 <del>15.<u>19.</u></del> "Rule" includes regulation. 21 <del>16.</del>20. "Sex" means the biological state of being male or female, based on the individual's 22 nonambiguous sex organs, chromosomes, and endogenous hormone profiles at birth. 23 <u>21.</u> "Signature" or "subscription" includes "mark" when the person cannot write, the 24 person's name being written near it and written by a person who writes that person's 25 own name as a witness. 26 <del>17.</del>22. "State" when applied to the different parts of the United States, includes the District of 27 Columbia and the territories. 28 <del>18.</del>23. "Testify" includes every mode of oral statement under oath or affirmation. 29 <del>19.</del>24. "United States" includes the District of Columbia and the territories. 30 <del>20.</del>25. "Will" includes codicils.

- 2 court or judicial officer.
- 3 **SECTION 2.** A new section to chapter 23-02.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

4 and enacted as follows:

# 5 <u>Vital statistics collection.</u>

- 6 <u>A school district or state agency or state department collecting vital statistics to comply with</u>
- 7 <u>a nondiscrimination law or to gather accurate public health, criminal, economic, or other data</u>
- 8 shall identify each individual in the collected data set as either male or female, based solely on
- 9 the individual's nonambiguous sex organs, chromosomes, and endogenous hormone profiles at
- 10 <u>birth.</u>
