- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 4.1-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the establishment of the livestock-friendly county designation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 4.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

5 and enacted as follows:

6	Livestock-friendly county d	esignation - Establishment by	commissioner.

- The commissioner shall establish a livestock-friendly county designation to recognize
 and assist efforts to develop, maintain, or expand livestock sectors within the counties
 of this state.
- <u>A county may apply to the commissioner to become designated as a livestock-friendly</u>
 <u>county. A county is eligible for the designation under this section if the county:</u>
- 12 a. <u>Through its board of county commissioners, has adopted and enacted a</u>
 13 <u>resolution expressing interest in developing, maintaining, or expanding livestock</u>
 14 production and processing sectors within the county;
- 15b.Intends to collaborate with all appropriate political subdivisions within the county16to develop, maintain, or expand livestock production and processing sectors;
- 17 <u>c.</u> <u>Has submitted a plan detailing the necessary actions to develop, maintain, or</u>
 18 <u>expand livestock production and processing sectors;</u>
- 19d.Has conducted and completed a study identifying suitable locations for rural20economic development, including locations for confined animal feeding
- 21 operations, agricultural processing facilities, agricultural storage facilities, and
 22 other agricultural-related development; and
- 23e.Has disclosed other existing or planned activities and initiatives within the county24to develop, maintain, or expand livestock production and processing sectors.

1	<u>3.</u>	If the commissioner determines a county has complied with the provisions in
2		subsection 2, the commissioner shall publicly designate the county as a livestock-
3		friendly county.
4	<u>4.</u>	To retain the designation, a county shall submit an application to the commissioner
5		every four years.
6	<u>5.</u>	The commissioner may revoke a county's designation as a livestock-friendly county if
7		the commissioner determines the county no longer meets the requirements for the
8		designation under subsection 2.
9	<u>6.</u>	The commissioner may adopt rules to effectuate the provisions of this section.
