- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 1 of section 4.1-53-48, subsection 3 of
- 2 section 4.1-53-57, subsection 2 of section 4.1-53-61, subsection 2 of section 4.1-55-17, and
- 3 section 4.1-57-22 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to requirements for certification
- 4 under the plant variety protection act; and to provide a penalty.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 4.1-53-48 of the North Dakota Century
7 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 8 1. If a certificate of plant variety protection issued under the Plant Variety Protection Act
- 9 [7 U.S.C. 2121 et seq.], as amended through July 31, <del>2020</del>2022, specifies that the 10 variety may be sold only as a class of certified seed, that seed must be certified by an 11 official seed-certifying agency before it can be advertised for sale, offered for sale, or 12 sold.
- SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subsection 3 of section 4.1-53-57 of the North Dakota Century
   Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- Any person found guilty of violating this chapter or the rules implementing this chapter
  is subject to a civil penalty in an amount not to exceed ten thousand dollars for each
- 17 violation. The civil penalty may be imposed by a court in a civil proceeding or by the
- 18 seed commissioner. <u>The seed commissioner may make application to the district court</u>
- 19 to compel payment of civil penalties imposed under this section.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 4.1-53-61 of the North Dakota Century
 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

22 2. Seed grown by a producer and sold by that producer without advertising and without
23 using a third party as an agent or broker to effect the sale, provided this exemption is
