# COMMUNITY SERVICES BLOCK GRANT (CSBG) PROGRAM

- Assists communities through Community Action Agencies in implementing anti-poverty programs.
  - Funded from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services through the state's seven Community Action Agencies
  - Funds are managed and distributed by Division of Community Services (DCS)



### COMMUNITY ACTION AGENCY (CAA)

- Emergency assistance
- Money management
- Housing counseling
- Self-sufficiency services
- Case management and outreach
- Referral services
- Workforce readiness



#### CSBG Funds

- Impacted 35,246 lowincome individuals
  - 13,000 children
  - 5,605 persons with disabilities
  - 5,379 people who lacked health insurance.





#### CARES FUNDING

- DCS received additional federal funds for the ESG and CSBG programs to assist with the challenges of the pandemic.
  - CSBG received an additional \$4,209,178.50 and from these funds
    - Community Action Agencies have assisted 4,984 low-income clients in 2020 and 2021.
    - An additional \$5,142,580 was received to provide support to the ESG grant.
