I AM DAVID CLEMENS AND I REPRESENT THE SENATE FROM DISTRICT 16. I AM HERE TO INTRODUCE SB 2350.

SB 2350 WOULD ALLOW A COUNTY, CITY OR TOWNSHIP TO AFFIX TO ANY TRAFFIC SIGN PROHIBITING ENGINE BRAKES AND SIGNIFYING THAT A VEHICLE NOISE ORDINANCE IS ENFORCED AND THE AMOUNT OF THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF AN OFFENSE CORRESPONDING WITH THE PURPOSE OF THE SIGN.

THE BILL ALSO LISTS ALL THE CONDITIONS THAT ARE REQUIRED SUCH AS A CURRENT ORDINANCE, A STATED PENALTY AND MEANS OF ENFORCEMENT. THE SIGNAGE ALSO NEEDS TO BE PURCHASED THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE REQUESTOR OF THE SIGN IS RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL COSTS OF MATERIAL, LABOR AND EQUIPMENT TO INSTALL THE SIGN.

THE PURPOSE OF THE BILL IS TO LIMIT THE AMOUNT OF NOISE VEHICLES CAN PRODUCE, ESPECIALLY WHEN ENTERING A CITY OR RESIDENTIAL AREA.

I HEREBY ASK FOR YOUR SUPPORT OF SB 2350 WITH A DO PASS RECOMMENDATION.
