Spring 2023 Headcount


Up 3.5% over Spring 2022 (From 1,558 to 1,633)

High School Seniors- 40 Year History



ND High School Graduates: Estimates based on K-12 count










2023-2025 Funds Request





LRSC Fund Breakdown 2023-2025 Biennium






LRSC Funding Formula


Deferred Maintenance Projects
