- 3 Good morning Chairman Elkin and members of the Senate
- ⁴ Education Committee. For the record, my name is Mike Bitz. I
- 5 am fortunate to serve as the superintendent for Mandan Public
- 6 Schools. I am here today in support of HB1185. I will be brief.
- 7 I don't often look to the government to solve problems, but HB
- 8 1185 is needed legislation
- 9 In April of 2021, 78% of Mandan School District voters approved
- an \$84,000,000 bond issue to build a new elementary school and
- a new high school. MPS was also planning to spend roughly
- \$10M in federal ESSER dollars to cover the \$94M estimated cost.
- When the project was bid in the summer of 2022 inflation had
- driven the project costs up to \$114,000,000. This is over a 20%
- increase over our pre-bid estimates.
- MPS is working hard to close this \$20M gap created by inflation
- without having to go back to our taxpayers. We received an
- \$8.5M CTE grant. We believe we will be able to raise \$3M from

- community partnerships, we hope to sell surrounding property for
- 2 another \$4M. We have some existing authority in our building
- fund, but this legislation would help us ensure that we don't need
- 4 to raise taxes for our residents beyond the \$99 in taxes for each
- 5 \$100,000 in property that we had told our taxpayers in our
- 6 information sessions prior to the referendum.
- 7 I urge you to vote YES on HB1185 and I would be happy to
- 8 answer any questions you may have.
