Eligible Disciplines

- Physicians (MD/DO)
 - Family Medicine
- Pediatrics
- Internal Medicine
- Psychiatry
- Obstetrics and Gynecology
- General/Pediatric Dentists (DDS, DMD)
- Registered Dental Hygienist
- Clinical Psychologist (PsyD, PhD)
- Licensed Clinical Social Worker (LCSW)
- Licensed Professional Counselor (LPC)
- Marriage and Family Therapist (MFT)
- Psychiatric Nurse Specialist (PNS)
- Registered Nurse (RN)
- Pharmacist (PharmD)
- Advanced Practice Providers (DNP, NP, CNM, PA)

Community Selection Criteria

- Must be located in a HPSA
- Sites must be a public or nonprofit status
- See all patients regardless of ability to pay
- Accept patients covered by Medicare, Medicaid and CHIP
- Not discriminate in the provision of services
- Must have a sliding fee scale or charity care plan

Financial Benefits

- Receive up to \$50,000 (depending on discipline) for a 2-year service obligation
- Opportunities for continuation contracts after initial 2-year service obligation

Service Location

Providers must serve in a Health Professional Shortage Area (HPSA)

Service Commitment

The obligation is a minimum of 2-years. Full-time and part-time available

Community Match

No Community Match commitment is required

Provider Selection Criteria

- Be a U.S. citizen or U.S. national
- Not have a current service obligation (currently part of a loan repayment program, etc.)
- Have unpaid government or commercial loans for school tuition, reasonable educational expenses and reasonable living expenses, segregated from all other debts



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
