I have personally overseen the acquisition, build out and operation of over 300 miles of pipeline within North Dakota. In my past employment, I was involved in the acquisition, reclamation, and operation of those same pipelines. I became involved in the Summit Carbon Solutions project because I believe that the two most important industries to North Dakota, namely Agriculture & Energy, will need to find a carbon management solution to continue to thrive. We have reviewed proposed Senate Bill No. 2251 and we are supportive for the following reasons:

- 1.) In my professional experience, landowner permission or in lieu thereof, a court order for survey permission, is a generally accepted practice in pipeline development; and
- 2.) As it is written, it is consistent with the actions of Summit Carbon Solutions
