- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the parks and
- 2 recreation department; to provide for a transfer; and to provide an exemption.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from other funds derived from special funds and 7 federal funds, to the parks and recreation department for the purpose of defraying the expenses 8 of the parks and recreation department and for providing a grant to the International Peace 9 Garden, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027, as follows: 10 Subdivision 1. 11

1 SECTION 3. NEW AND VACANT FTE POOL - LIMITATION - TRANSFER REQUEST. The 2 parks and recreation department may not spend funds appropriated in the new and vacant FTE 3 pool line item in section 1 of this Act, but may request the office of management and budget to 4 transfer funds from the new and vacant FTE pool line item to other line items with salaries and 5 wages in accordance with the guidelines and reporting provisions included in House Bill 6 No. 1015, as approved by the sixty-ninth legislative assembly. 7 SECTION 4. ADDITIONAL INCOME - APPROPRIATION - REPORTING. In addition to the 8 amounts appropriated in section 1 of this Act, any additional federal or special funds that 9 become available are appropriated to the parks and recreation department, for the biennium 10 beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. The department shall report any additional 11 income under this section to the office of management and budget and the legislative council. 12 SECTION 5. TRANSFER - GAME AND FISH DEPARTMENT TO PARKS AND 13 **RECREATION DEPARTMENT - GAME AND FISH OPERATING FUND - BOAT RAMP** 14 **OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE.** The sum of \$122,000, or so much of the sum as may be 15 necessary, included in the park operations and maintenance line item in subdivision 1 of 16 section 1 of this Act, is from the game and fish operating fund, or federal or other funds 17 available to the game and fish department, which must be transferred to the parks and

recreation department for maintenance, operating, and extraordinary repairs expenses relating
to boat ramps at state parks for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30,
2027.

21 SECTION 6. OTHER FUNDS - STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS

22 FUND - DEFERRED MAINTENANCE - PARK GRANTS. The other funds line item in section 1 23 of this Act includes \$27,491,500 from the strategic investment and improvements fund, of which 24 \$12,500,000 is for deferred maintenance at state parks, \$924,000 is for comfort stations at state 25 parks, \$2,500,000 is for state parks technology enhancements, \$1,250,000 is for state parks 26 matching funds, \$7,500,000 is for park grants, \$1,500,000 is for an international music camp 27 complex revitalization project at the International Peace Garden, \$1,000,000 is for a sewer 28 system upgrade project at the International Peace Garden, and \$317,500 is for a cactus 29 conservatory project at the International Peace Garden. The parks and recreation department 30 may use funding appropriated for deferred maintenance at state parks for the purchase of 31 buildings to replace currently owned buildings that are beyond feasible repair. The parks and

2	outdoor recreational facilities for outdoor activities to be used by children and young adults.		
3	SECTION 7. INTERNATIONAL PEACE GARDEN. The International Peace Garden line		
4	item in s	ection 1 of this Act includes \$3,943,829 for projects at the International Peace Garden,	
5	which th	e parks and recreation department may provided only to the extent the funds are	
6	matched	by the province of Manitoba at a value equal to the United States dollar exchange rate	
7	on July 1	1, 2025.	
8	SEC	TION 8. EXEMPTION - UNEXPENDED APPROPRIATIONS. The following	
9	appropri	ations are not subject to the provisions of section 54-44.1-11 and may be continued into	
10	the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027:

19		chapter 51 of the 2023 Session Laws.	
20	3.	The sum of \$50,000 appropriated from the general fund for the Fort Abraham Lincoln	
21		viewshed lease in subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 19 of the 2021 Session Laws	
22		and continued into the 2023-25 biennium in section 9 of chapter 51 of the 2023	
23		Session Laws for plantings to improve the viewshed.	
24	4.	The sum of \$10,000,000 appropriated from the federal state fiscal recovery fund for	
25		deferred maintenance and capital projects in subsection 9 of section 1 of chapter 550

28	5.	The sum of \$5,000,000 appropriated from the state fiscal recovery fund for the grants	
29		to local park districts to renovate and upgrade existing facilities in subsection 5 of	
30		section 1 of chapter 550 of the 2021 Special Session Session Laws and continued into	
31		the 2023-25 biennium in section 9 of chapter 51 of the 2023 Session Laws.	

1	6.	The sum of \$1,632,800 appropriated from the state fiscal recovery fund and local
2		matching funds for capital project improvements at state parks, subject to the parks
3		and recreation department obtaining matching funds from nonstate sources for each
4		project on a dollar-for-dollar basis in section 7 of chapter 19 of the 2021 Session Laws
5		as amended in section 4 of chapter 548 of the 2021 Special Session Session Laws
6		and continued into the 2023-25 biennium in section 9 of chapter 51 of the 2023
7		Session Laws.
8	7.	The sum of \$7,900,000 appropriated from the state fiscal recovery fund for the
9		deferred maintenance and capital projects in section 6 of chapter 19 of the 2021
10		Session Laws as amended by section 3 of chapter 548 of the 2021 Special Session
11		Session Laws and continued into the 2023-25 biennium in section 9 of chapter 51 of
12		the 2023 Session Laws.
13	8.	The sum of \$800,000 appropriated from the strategic investment and improvements
14		fund for a pavilion construction project at the International Peace Garden in
15		subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 51 of the 2023 Session Laws.
16	9.	The sum of \$10,000,000 appropriated from the strategic investment and
17		improvements fund for deferred maintenance and capital projects in subdivision 1 of
18		section 1 of chapter 51 of the 2023 Session Laws.
19	10.	The sum of \$2,400,000 appropriated from the strategic investment and improvements
20		fund for a cabin construction project in subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 51 of the
21		2023 Session Laws.
22	11.	The sum of \$250,000 appropriated from the strategic investment and improvements
23		fund for a Lake Metigoshe reimagined project in subdivision 1 of section 1 of
24		chapter 51 of the 2023 Session Laws.
25	12.	The sum of \$6,000,000 appropriated from the strategic investment and improvements
26		fund for city, county, and tribal park system grants in subdivision 1 of section 1 of
27		chapter 51 of the 2023 Session Laws.
28	13.	The sum of \$70,000,000 appropriated from special funds derived from a Bank of North
29		Dakota line of credit for the Theodore Roosevelt presidential library project in
30		subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 51 of the 2023 Session Laws.

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1	14.	The sum of \$6,000,000 appropriated from the strategic investment and improvements
2		fund for a Pembina Gorge campground project in subdivision 1 of section 1 of
3		chapter 51 of the 2023 Session Laws.
4	15.	The sum of \$3,000,000 appropriated from the strategic investment and improvements
5		fund and local matching funds for state park matching grants subject to the parks and
6		recreation department obtaining matching funds from nonstate sources for each
7		project on a dollar-for-dollar basis in subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 51 of the
