4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 44-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Public comment - Regular meetings of a public entity.

- Every regular meeting of a governing body of a city, county, township, school district,
 park district, or water resource district must include an opportunity for an individual to
 provide public comment.
- An individual providing comment at a meeting shall provide to the governing body in
 writing the individual's name and address. The individual's address is an exempt
 record.
- 14 3. A governing body of a city, county, township, school district, park district, or water
 resource district:
 - a. May limit a public comment only as follows, except as provided in subdivision b:
 - (1) By time per speaker, total time for public comment, or both.
- 18 (2) By agenda topic, to the agendas of the current and at least one preceding meeting.
- b. Shall develop a policy regarding public comment rules for regular meetings. The
 policy may provide a public comment:
- 22 (1) Must be pertinent to the public entity.

1	<u>(2)</u>	May not interfere with the orderly conduct of the regular meeting.
2	<u>(3)</u>	May not be defamatory, abusive, harassing, or unlawful.
3	<u>(4)</u>	May be prohibited if an alternative procedure exists to bring that particular
4		type of public comment before the public entity, the public comment includes
5		confidential or exempt information, or the public comment is otherwise
6		prohibited by law.
