- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact three new sections to chapter 43-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to restricted, temporary, and retired barber licenses; to amend and
- 3 reenact sections 43-04-01, 43-04-04, 43-04-06, 43-04-30, 43-04-30.1, 43-04-32, and 43-04-42
- 4 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the board of barber examiners, barber licensing,
- 5 continuing education, and fees; and to provide a penalty.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 43-04-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is

8 amended and reenacted as follows:

- 10 In this chapter, unless the context or subject matter otherwise requires:
- 11 1. "Board" means the board of barber examiners.
- 12 2. <u>"Licensed barber" means a licensee who has:</u>
 - a. Met the requirements defined in sections 43-04-31 and 43-04-32; and
 - b. Passed the examination required in section 43-04-33.
- 15 <u>3.</u> "Practice of barbering" includes any one or any combination of the following practices
 16 when done upon the upper part of the human body for cosmetic purposes and not for
 17 the treatment of diseases or physical or mental ailments, and when done for payment
 18 either directly or indirectly:
- 19 a. Shaving or trimming the beard or cutting the hair.
- b. Giving facial or scalp massages or treatments with oils, creams, lotions, or other
 preparations either by hand or mechanical appliances.
- 22 c. Singeing, shampooing, or dyeing the hair or applying hair tonics.

1		d.	Applying cosmetic preparations, antiseptics, powders, oils, clays, or lotions to	
2			scalp, face, neck, or upper part of the body.	
3	<u>4.</u>	<u>"Re</u>	stricted barber" means a licensee, limited in practice to specific areas in which	
4		<u>com</u>	petence has been demonstrated, and allowed to work in a licensed host shop.	
5	<u>5.</u>	"Retired barber" means a licensee who meets the requirements of section 9 of this		
6		<u>Act.</u>		
7	<u>6.</u>	<u>"Ter</u>	mporary barber" means an eligible licensee who is permitted to practice under the	
8		<u>sup</u>	ervision of a licensed barber until results are available from the next scheduled	
9		<u>exa</u>	mination.

24		a. Individuals holding a barber license or a barber instructor license shall complete	<u>ə</u>		
25		a minimum of six hours of continuing education every two years;

6	<u>1.</u>	Any person who desires to take the examination for a certificate of registration to		
7		practice as a registered barber shall make application to the board on blanks prepared		
8		and furnished by the board and shall enclose with the application all of the following:		
9	1.	Proof, under oath, of the person's qualifications.		
10	2.	A five-inch by three-inch [12.7-centimeter by 7.62-centimeter] signed photograph of		
11		that person. The person also shall present such a photograph to the board when the		
12		person appears for examination.

14	4.	A certificate showing graduation from a public or recognized private high school or an-		
15		equivalent education as determined by an examination conducted by the board;		
16		provided, however, that two years armed service should be termed equivalent

19		applicant pays the required application fee and:

23		sanitation, safety, laws, and rules, including the completion of hours at a licensed		
24		barbering school or a barbering program in a public school system, and other		
25		procedures as established by the board.

27		section 43-04-31, passes the licensing examination under section 43-04-33, and pays		
28		the initial licensing fee.		
29	<u>4.</u>	An applicant who fails to pass the examination under section 43-04-33 may take		
30		subsequent examinations as necessary, subject to the following:		
31		a. The board may specify reasonable time frames for rescheduling the examination;

6		<u>C.</u>	An individual may not continue to practice under this subsection if the individual	
7			fails to pass the examination on the second attempt.

14		<u>a.</u>	Is valid for a maximum of three months;	
15		<u>b.</u>	Must begin from the verified date of graduation or completion of training; and	
16		<u>C.</u>	May be exercised only under the supervision of a licensed barber until results are	
17			available from the next scheduled examination.	
18	<u>3.</u>	<u>lf th</u>	e temporary license holder fails the examination, the temporary license holder may	
19		<u>app</u>	ly for an extension of the individual's license under this chapter, pay the fee, and	
20		<u>reg</u> i	register for the next scheduled examination.	
21	SECTION 9. A new section to chapter 43-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created			
22	and ena	cted	as follows:	
23	Retired barber license - Requirements.			
24	<u>1.</u>	<u>An</u>	individual may apply for a retired barber license and practice in a limited capacity if	
25		<u>the</u>	applicant is:	
26		<u>a.</u>	At least sixty-five years of age or has been practicing a minimum of twenty years	
27			as a licensed barber; and	
28		<u>b.</u>	Works no more than five days per month.	
29	<u>2.</u>	Upon an applicant meeting the qualifications under this section and paying the initial		
30		lice	nsing fee, the board shall issue a retired barber license.

5		a.	For examination and issuance of a certificate to practice master barbering, one	
6			hundred dollars.	
7		b.	For renewal of a master barber's certificate, one hundred dollars.	
8		C.	For restoration of an expired master barber's certificate, a twenty dollar penalty	
9			fee in addition to the regular renewal fee.	
10		d.	For a permit to operate a barber school or college, an annual fee of one hundred	
11			twenty-five dollars.	
12		e.	For issuance of an annual barbershop license, fifty dollars, to be paid by each	
13			shop owner in advance.	
14		f.	For issuance of a certificate to an applicant who qualifies under section	
15			43-04-38.1, one hundred seventy-five dollars.	
16		g.	For restoration of an expired barbershop license, a twenty dollar penalty fee in	
17			addition to the annual license fee.	
18		h.	For renewal of an instructor's license, twenty-fivetwo hundred fifty dollars.	
19	2.	Eac	ch application to open or establish a barbershop in this state must be accompanied	
20		by a	a fee of one hundred dollars to cover expenses of inspection, which must be	
21		reta	ined by the board and deposited as other fees.	
22	3.	A dı	uplicate license, certificate, or permit must be issued upon:	
23		a.	Filing a statement verified by the oath of the applicant which explains the loss;	
24		b.	Submitting a signed photograph of the applicant; and	
25		C.	Paying a fee of ten dollars for the issuance of the duplicate.	
26	4.	Any	one who becomes a member of the armed forces of the United States in time of	
27		war	, while holding a license as a barber or apprentice, and while in good standing as	
28		to p	ayment of fees, may obtain a certificate restoration without payment of the	
29		rest	toration fee.
