## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 15.1-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 7 and enacted as follows:

## Human trafficking and exploitation prevention and awareness education.

- 1. The board of a school district, the governing board of a nonpublic school, and the
   governing board of a school operated by a tribal government shall:
  - a. Adopt a policy regarding human trafficking and exploitation prevention and awareness education for students and staff. The policy may include the development of partnerships with community organizations, such as law enforcement, churches, parent and family organizations, and civic organizations, to offer education under this section. As used in this section, "human trafficking"
    - <u>b.</u> Offer to parents and legal guardians optional workshops or materials or both to support the education of the child of the parent or legal guardian on personal safety and grooming prevention.
- 20 2. The education under this section:

includes sex trafficking.

 a. May be provided by a nonprofit organization specializing in outreach and education on human trafficking and exploitation.
