- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-21-26 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to special restrictions on lamps on motor vehicles or equipment.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-21-26 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

- 6 **39-21-26. Special restrictions on lamps.**
- Any lighted lamp or illuminating device uponon a motor vehicle, other than headlamps,
   spot lamps, auxiliary lamps, flashing turn signals, emergency vehicle warning lamps
   and schoolbus warning lamps, which projects a beam of light of an intensity greater
   than three hundred candlepower must be so directed so that no part of the
- high-intensity portion of the beam will strike the level of the roadway on which the
  vehicle stands at a distance of more than seventy-five feet [22.86 meters] from the
  vehicle.
- 14 2. <u>NoA</u> person may <u>not</u> drive or move any vehicle or equipment <u>uponon</u> any highway with
- 15 any<u>a</u> lamp or device thereon displaying a red or green light visible from directly in front
- 16 of the center thereof of the vehicle or equipment. This section does not apply to any a
- vehicle upon which a red light visible from the front is expressly authorized or requiredby this chapter.
- 19 3. Flashing lights are prohibited except on an authorized:
- 20 <u>a.</u> <u>An authorized</u> emergency vehicle, schoolbus, snow-removal equipment;
- 21 <u>b.</u> <u>A schoolbus;</u>
- 22 <u>c.</u> <u>Snow-removal equipment;</u>
- 23d.A vehicle owned by a funeral home while used for the purpose of escorting a24funeral procession; or on any

- 1 <u>e.</u> <u>Any</u> vehicle as a means of indicating a right or left turn, or the presence of a
- 2 vehicular traffic hazard requiring unusual care in approaching, overtaking, or
- 3 passing.
