- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 34-0554-60 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to an apprenticeship grant program; and to provide an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 34-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
and enacted as follows:

SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-60 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Apprenticeship grant program.

- The labor commissioner shall administer an apprenticeship grant program to provide grants to eligible individuals enrolled in qualifying registered apprenticeship programs within this state.
- 2. The labor-commissioner, in collaboration with the United States department of labor and the state board for career and technical education shall:
 - a. Establish eligibility guidelines for the program, including requiring full-time enrollment, program progress, and a minimum grade point average or its equivalent; and
 - b. Award an eligible individual up to three thousand dollars within a three-year period while enrolled in an eligible program.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND HUMAN

20 RIGHTSCOMMERCE - APPRENTICESHIP GRANT PROGRAM. There is appropriated out of
