1 A BILL for an Act to provide for a legislative management study relating to immigration law.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 3 SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - IMMIGRATION LAW.
- During the 2025-26 interim, the legislative management shall consider studying federal 1. 5 jurisdiction over immigration law, illegal immigration, and immigration law in other states. The study must include:
 - An overview of federal pre-emption of state or local law related to immigration. a.
 - A survey of the laws of this state and other states regarding individuals living and b. working in the United States without authorization.
 - A review of case law affecting the states' ability to enact laws regarding unauthorized workers.
 - Information regarding the manner in which local law enforcement agencies d. coordinate with federal law enforcement agencies.
 - Input from the private sector and pro-business lobbyists, the office of the attorney general, and the secretary of state.
 - 2. The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the seventieth legislative assembly.
