- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 61-02 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to a temporary moratorium on conducting an economic analysis for
- 3 assessment drain projects; to amend and reenact section 61-02-01.3 of the North Dakota
- 4 Century Code, relating to comprehensive water development plans; to provide for a legislative
- 5 management study; and to provide an expiration date.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

## 7 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 61-02-01.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is

8 amended and reenacted as follows:

## 9 61-02-01.3. Comprehensive water development plan.

- <u>1.</u> Biennially, the commission shall develop and maintain a comprehensive water
   development plan organized on a river basin perspective, including an inventory of
   future water projects for budgeting and planning purposes.
- 13 <u>2.</u> As part of the commission's planning process, to facilitate local project sponsor
- 14 participation and project prioritization and to assist in education regarding life cycle
- 15 analyses for municipal water supply projects, and economic analyses for flood control
- 16 and water conveyance projects expected to cost more than one million dollars, the
- 17 commission shall develop a policy that outlines procedures for commissioner-hosted
- 18 meetings within the upper Missouri River, lower Missouri River, James River, upper
- 19 Red River, lower Red River, Mouse River, Devils Lake, Little Missouri River, upper
- 20 Heart River, and upper Cannonball River drainage basins.

- 1 <u>3.</u> <u>The commission may not require an economic analysis for an assessment drain</u>
- 2 project if the project is expected to cost one million dollars or less.
- 3 SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 61-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
  4 and enacted as follows:
- 5 <u>Economic analysis for assessment drain projects Moratorium.</u>
- 6 Notwithstanding section 61-02-01.3, between August 1, 2025, and July 31, 2027, the state
- 7 water commission or the department of water resources may not conduct an economic analysis
- 8 for an assessment drain project within the state.
- 9 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY FORMULA FOR ECONOMIC

## 10 ANALYSIS FOR ASSESSMENT DRAIN PROJECTS. During the 2025-26 interim, the

- 11 legislative management shall study the formula for conducting an economic analysis for
- 12 assessment drain projects and the projected cost threshold for conducting economic analyses.
- 13 The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any
- 14 legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the seventieth legislative assembly.
- 15 SECTION 4. EXPIRATION DATE. Section 2 of this Act is effective through July 31, 2027,
- 16 and after that date is ineffective.
