- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-35 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the creation of a legislative task force on government efficiency; to
- 3 provide for a legislative management report; to provide an expiration date; and to declare an
- 4 emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-35 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

7 and enacted as follows:

8 Legislative task force on government efficiency - Members - Duties - Report to the

9 legislative management.

- 10 <u>1.</u> <u>The legislative management shall create a legislative task force on government</u>
 11 efficiency.
- 12 <u>2.</u> Each member of the task force shall serve two-year terms. The membership of the
 13 task force consists of:
- 14 <u>a.</u> <u>The director of the office of management and budget;</u>
- 15 <u>b.</u> <u>The chief operating officer for the office of the governor;</u>
- 16 <u>c.</u> <u>One elected statewide officer, appointed by the governor;</u>
- 17 <u>d.</u> <u>One individual residing in the state, appointed by the governor;</u>
- 18e.Three members of the house of representatives, appointed by the majority leader19of the house of representatives; and
- 20 <u>f.</u> <u>Three members of the senate, appointed by the majority leader of the senate.</u>

7		<u>b.</u>	Review and analyze budgets and reports from executive branch agencies and
8			the supreme court.
9		<u>c.</u>	Collaborate with and receive testimony from executive branch agencies and the
10			supreme court to identify areas to increase efficiency and methods to implement
11			cost-saving measures, determine areas of state government deemed
12			unnecessary or duplicative, target outdated or overly restrictive regulations, and
13			find areas in which partnerships between the state and private industry would
14			create innovative financing models to drive economic growth and job creation.

- 2 force through July 31, 2031.
- 3 **SECTION 2. EXPIRATION DATE.** This Act is effective through July 31, 2031, and after that
- 4 date is ineffective.
- 5 **SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
