- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-36 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the review of introduced legislation by the Indian affairs commission
- 3 and tribal consultation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-36 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 6 and enacted as follows:

7 <u>Review of introduced legislation - Tribal consultation.</u>

- 8 <u>1.</u> Each legislative session, the director of the Indian affairs commission shall review all
 9 legislation introduced to the legislative assembly and determine if the legislation
- 10 pertains to matters with tribal implications.
- 11 <u>2.</u> If the director determines a bill pertains to matters with tribal implications, the director
 12 shall consult with the tribal chairpersons of each tribe.
- 13 <u>3.</u> For purposes of this section:
- 14a."Consult" means the direct and interactive involvement of the North Dakota tribal15governments in the development of policy on matters with tribal implications.
- 16 which includes a proactive, affirmative process of identifying and seeking input
- 17 <u>from appropriate tribal governments and considering the tribal governments' input</u>
 18 <u>as a necessary and integral part of the decisionmaking process.</u>
- 19 <u>b.</u> <u>"Matters with tribal implications" means a legislative measure that has a</u>
- 20 <u>substantial direct effect on one or more tribal nations within the geographical</u>

- 21 boundaries of the state or on the distribution of power and responsibilities
- 22 <u>between the state and tribal governments.</u>
