- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 44-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to designating student applications for admission to an institution of
- 3 higher education as exempt records; and to declare an emergency.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 44-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 7 Admissions applications to institutions of higher education Exempt.
- 8 A record related to an individual's application for admission to an institution of higher
- 9 <u>education under the administration of the state board of higher education is exempt, except as</u>
- 10 otherwise provided by law. Subject to the retention requirements under section 15-10-44, the
- 11 record must be destroyed upon request of the applicant or the parent or guardian of an
- 12 applicant who was under eighteen years of age at the time the application was submitted. An
- 13 individual may not access or disclose an exempt record under this section for a reason other
- than carrying out regular duties as an employee of an institution of higher education, except as
- 15 otherwise provided under this chapter.
- 16 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
