- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 23-12 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to an opt-out procedure for required vaccines.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 23-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Required vaccine Opt-out procedure Exemptions.
- 7 <u>1.</u> Notwithstanding any other provision of law, except as provided in subsections 2 and 3,
- 8 <u>a state agency, political subdivision, or any other government entity, may not require</u>
- 9 <u>an individual to take or receive a vaccine or similar product used to prevent a disease,</u>
- 10 <u>unless there is a procedure made available for an opt-out for health, religious, or</u>
- 11 philosophical reasons.
- 12 <u>2. The following entities are exempt from subsection 1:</u>
- 13 a. The department of corrections and rehabilitation:
- b. A correctional facility as defined under section 12-44.1-01;
- 15 <u>c.</u> <u>A law enforcement agency:</u>
- 16 <u>d.</u> A local public health unit;
- 17 <u>e. A human service zone;</u>
- 18 <u>f. The state hospital;</u>
- 19 <u>g. A developmental disability residential facility or other health care provider,</u>
- including a long-term care provider, basic care provider, and assisted living

- h. A school, day care center, child care facility, head start program, or nursery
 school in compliance with section 23-07-17.1.
- 3. This section does not apply during a public health disaster or emergency declared
 4 under chapter 37-17.1.
