- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 23-12 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to an opt-out procedure for required vaccines.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 23-12 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 Required vaccine Opt-out procedure Exemptions.
- Unless otherwise provided by law, a state agency, political subdivision, or any other
 government entity, may not require an individual to take or receive a vaccine or similar
 product used to prevent a disease, unless there is a procedure made available for an
 opt-out for health, religious, or philosophical reasons.
- 11 2. The following entities are exempt from subsection 1:
 - a. The department of corrections and rehabilitation;
- 13 b. A correctional facility as defined under section 12-44.1-01;
- 14 c. A local public health unit;
- 15 <u>d. A human service zone:</u>
- 16 <u>e. The state hospital;</u>

- 17 <u>f. A developmental disability residential facility or other health care provider,</u>
- 18 <u>including a long-term care provider, basic care provider, and assisted living</u>

- 20 g. A school, day care center, child care facility, head start program, or nursery
