- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-44.4 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the duties of the superintendent of public instruction and the
- 3 establishment of a government spending database; to provide an appropriation; and to provide
- 4 an effective date.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 54-44.4 of the North Dakota Century Code is created

7 and enacted as follows:

- 10 <u>1.</u> <u>As used in this section, "submitting party" means:</u>
- 11 <u>a.</u> <u>A budget unit under section 54-44.1-04;</u>
- 12 <u>b.</u> <u>A political subdivision;</u>
- 13 <u>c.</u> <u>A school district; and</u>
- 14 <u>d.</u> <u>An institution under the control of the state board of higher education.</u>
- 15 <u>2.</u> <u>The superintendent of public instruction shall collect data from submitting parties and</u>
- 16 <u>establish and maintain a government spending database that is accessible without</u>
- 17 <u>cost through the internet and contains detailed expenditure data collected from</u>
- 18 <u>submitting parties. The data must be updated at least monthly.</u>
- 19 <u>3.</u> <u>The database must include for each expenditure:</u>
- 20 <u>a.</u> <u>The amount paid.</u>
- 21 <u>b.</u> <u>The payment date.</u>
- 22 <u>c.</u> <u>The recipient name.</u>

2		<u>e.</u>	The employee position, if for a personnel payment.
3		<u>f.</u>	For a school district, with respect to educational materials:
4			(1) <u>A description of curriculum.</u>
5			(2) The publisher and author of a textbook.

7		<u>g.</u>	A standardized categorization using United States census bureau codes for state
8			and local transactions and nationally recognized standardized codes for school
9			districts and institutions of higher education.

11		<u>a.</u>	Search capabilities.
12		<u>b.</u>	Data aggregation tools.

19	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION -		
20	GOVERNMENT SPENDING DATABASE - ONE-TIME FUNDING. There is appropriated out of		
21	any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of		
22	\$500,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of public instruction		
23	for the purpose of establishing and maintaining a government spending database, for the		
24	biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. The funding provided in this		
25	section is considered a one time funding item.
