- 1. During the 2025-26 interim, the department of transportation shall study relevant issues in order to develop a preemptive regulatory and statutory framework for the operation of autonomous and semiautonomous vehicles on the North Dakota highway system. The study must include:
 - A process for determining where the state's infrastructure may or may not be fully prepared for widespread deployment of autonomous and semiautonomous vehicle technologies;
 - A process to review accident and traffic data for autonomous and semiautonomous vehicle systems with independent oversight on the industry operators;
 - c. If there is a need to promulgate rules relating to accident liability regarding autonomous and semiautonomous vehicle technologies; and
- d. A determination of common vulnerabilities relating to privacy concerns and data security with proposed solutions.
