- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation to the department of commerce for tribal tourism
- 2 grants; and to provide for a legislative management report.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE - TRIBAL TOURISM
5	GRANTS - ONE-TIME FUNDING - LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT REPORT. There is
6	appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise
7	appropriated, the sum of \$100,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the
8	department of commerce for the purpose of providing tribal tourism grants, for the biennium
9	beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2027. A tribal government in the state may apply to
10	the department of commerce for a grant of up to \$20,000 to match funds committed by a tribal
11	government to promote and enhance tribal nation tourism opportunities. A grant application
12	must include a plan for using funds to promote and enhance tribal nation tourism opportunities
13	to be overseen by the department of commerce division of tourism. The department of
14	commerce shall report to legislative management regarding the distribution, use, and impact of
15	grants. The appropriation provided in this section is considered a one-time funding item.
