<sup>1</sup> One-time funding of \$400,000 is added from the general fund for tribal tourism grants to provide a total of \$500,000. The House approved \$100,000. The amendment also increases the maximum grant award a tribal government is eligible for from \$20,000 to \$100,000 and requires a tribal government that receives a grant to provide matching funds of 10 percent (\$10,000).
