A concurrent resolution honoring the police and first responders of Fargo, North Dakota.

WHEREAS, the swift actions of first responders prevented further loss of life and ensured public safety during this critical event; and

WHEREAS, Officer Jake Wallin of the Fargo Police Department made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty while protecting his community;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

That the Sixty-ninth Legislative Assembly honors Officer Jake Wallin for his heroism and extends heartfelt condolences to his family, friends, and colleagues; commends Officer Andrew Dotas, Officer Tyler Hawes, and Sergeant Zach Robinson, for their bravery and resilience in the face of danger; expresses sincerest gratitude to our nurses, doctors, and all other first responders for their dedication to serving and protecting the Fargo community; and encourages continued support for law enforcement officers and first responders who risk their lives daily to ensure public safety; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State forward copies of this resolution to the Fargo Police Department, Officer Andrew Dotas, Officer Tyler Hawes, Sergeant Zach Robinson, Karlee Koswick, and the fiance and family of Officer Jake Wallin.
