BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6	SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 46-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
7	and enacted as follows:
8	— Government publication.
9	A unit of government may file a published notice with the secretary of state whenever the
10	unit of government is required by law to publish notice in a newspaper. Unless otherwise
11	provided by law, a notice required by law which is filed and posted by the secretary of state
12	fulfills publication requirements if a newspaper fails to publish the notice required by law.
13	SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 46-05-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is
14	amended and reenacted as follows:
15	46-05-09. Publication of legal notices on website.
16	1. When a legal notice is required by law to be published in a newspaper, if the request
17	for publication is submitted to:
18	a. A newspaper, the newspaper also shall publish the notice on a statewide legal
19	notices website maintained by the North Dakota newspaper association and on
20	the newspaper's website in a location open and free to the public, if the

- newspaper maintains a website, at no additional cost to the entity placing the notice.
- b. The North Dakota newspaper association, the association shall publish the notice
 on a statewide legal notices website maintained by the North Dakota newspaper
 association and provide an affidavit of publication.
- 2. If an insubstantial error in the notice occurs as a result of placement on the website and the error is the fault of the newspaper, the error does not affect the validity and effectiveness of the notice.
- 3. A notice required by law which is published on a statewide legal notices website

 maintained by the North Dakota newspaper association or on a website maintained by
 the proper governmental unit, fulfills the publication requirement if a newspaper fails to
 publish the notice required by law.
