- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 46-05-09 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to publication requirements for legal notices.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 46-05-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 46-05-09. Publication of legal notices on website.
- 7 <u>1.</u> When a legal notice is required by law to be published in a newspaper, <u>if the request</u>
 8 <u>for publication is submitted to:</u>
 - a. A newspaper, the newspaper also shall publish the notice on a statewide legal notices website maintained by the North Dakota newspaper association and on the newspaper's website in a location open and free to the public, if the newspaper maintains a website, at no additional cost to the entity placing the notice.
 - b. The North Dakota newspaper association, the association shall publish the notice
 on a statewide legal notices website maintained by the North Dakota newspaper
 association and provide an affidavit of publication.
 - 2. If an insubstantial error in the notice occurs as a result of placement on the website and the error is the fault of the newspaper, the error does not affect the validity and effectiveness of the notice.
- 3. A notice required by law which is published on a statewide legal notices website
 maintained by the North Dakota newspaper association or on a website maintained by

- 1 <u>the proper governmental unit, fulfills the publication requirement if a newspaper fails to</u>
- 2 <u>publish the notice required by law.</u>
