Judiciary Committee (Rep. Klemin, Chairman) recommends AMENDMENTS (25.0923.01001) and when so amended, recommends DO PASS (8 YEAS, 6 NAYS, 0 ABSENT AND NOT VOTING). HB 1416 was placed on the Sixth order on the calendar.

The House stood adjourned pursuant to Representative Bosch's motion.
