- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsections 7 and 21 of section 53-06.1-01,
- 2 subdivision a of subsection 1 of section 53-06.1-03, subsection 2 of section 53-06.1-10.1, and
- 3 subdivision c of subsection 2 of section 53-06.1-11.1 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating
- 4 to the definitions of an educational organization and public-spirited organization, and raffles; and
- 5 to provide for application.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsections 7 and 21 of section 53-06.1-01 of the North

8 Dakota Century Code are amended and reenacted as follows:

- 9 7. "Educational organization" means a nonprofit public or private elementary or
- 10 secondary school, two-year or four-year college, or university. <u>The term includes a</u>
- 11 <u>collegiate athletic organization and an educational public service organization when</u>
 providing educational activities.
- 13 21. "Public-spirited organization" means an organization whose the primary purpose of
- 14 <u>which</u> is for scientific research, amateur sports competition, safety, literaryliterature,
- 15 arts, preservation of cultural heritage, educational activities, educational public service,
- 16 youth, economic development, tourism, designated convention and visitors bureau, or
- 17 community medical care<u>., community recreation, or similar organization, which does</u>
- 18 not meet the definition of any other type of eligible organization. However, a domestic
- 19 nonprofit organization or a group of people recognized as a public-spirited organization
- by a governing body of a city or county for obtaining a permit does not need to meet this
- 21 definition.any other organization, or group recognized by a governing body of a city or
- 22 county, organized and operated not for pecuniary profit or gain but for the primary
- 23 purpose of improving or alleviating a condition of public concern within the state or
- 24 conferring a direct benefit on the community at large. The term does not include a
- 25 nonprofit club, association, or organization, the primary purpose of which is to provide a
- 26 <u>direct benefit to its officers or members</u>.

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1	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Subdivision a of subsection 1 of section 53-06.1-03 of the					
2	North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:					
3		a.	An or	ganization recognized as a <u>A</u> domestic nonprofit public-spirited organization or		
4			group	o of people recognized by the governing body of a city or county may apply for		
5			perm	its. A local permit may allow the organization to conduct only raffles, bingo, or		
6			sport	s pools. A restricted event permit may allow the organization to conduct only		
7			raffle	s, bingo, sports pools, paddlewheels, twenty-one, and poker. The organization		
8			or clo	osely related organizations as a whole may only award a primary prize that		
9			does	not exceed eight thousand dollars and total prizes of all games do not		
10			exce	ed forty thousand dollars per year. These maximum prize amounts do not		
11			apply	to raffles conducted under chapter 20.1-08. The determination of what is a		
12			<u>dome</u>	estic nonprofit "public-spirited organization" is within the sole discretion of the		
13			gove	rning body. An organization shall disclose on the application its intended use		
14			of the	e net income from the gaming activity. A governing body may issue a permit for		
15			game	es to be held at designated times and places.

17	Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

25			(1)	Scholarships for students, if the disbursement is deposited in a scholarship		
26				fund for defraying the cost of education to students and the scholarships are		
27				awarded through an open and fair selection process.		
28			(2)	Supplementary assistance to a public or private nonprofit educational		
29				institution registered with or accredited by any state.		

1	(3)	Assistance to libraries and museums.				
2	(4)	Assistance for the performing arts and humanities.				
3	(5)	Preservation of cultural heritage.				
4	(6)	Youth community , <u>and</u> , youth athletic, and social welfare , and athletic				
5		activities.				
6	(7)	Adult amateur athletic activities within the state, including team uniforms				
7		and equipment.				
8	(8)	Maintenance of places of public worship or support of a body of				
9		communicants, gathered in common membership for mutual support and				
10		edification in piety, worship, or religious observances.				
11	(9) (8)	Scientific research.				
12	SECTION 5. APPLICATION. This Act applies to an eligible organization applying for or					
13	renewing a license after the effective date of this Act.
