- 4 I am writing to express my support for SB 2244, which seeks to affirm and

- 8 educational system accepts public dollars, directly or indirectly, there needs
- 9 to be public accountability.
- However, while we support the bill's intent, we respectfully suggest a
- couple of amendments to ensure that parental rights are applied fairly and
- equitably across all educational settings:
  - 1. **Inclusion of All Children**: The bill should explicitly state that parental rights extend to all children, regardless of whether they attend public, private, or charter schools. The choice of a private education should not require parents to forfeit their fundamental rights in guiding their child's education.
  - Removal of Section 2, Part 5: This section should be deleted because existing school district policies already provide appropriate avenues for parents to seek relief in cases of disputes or concerns. Adding additional provisions may create unnecessary redundancies and bureaucratic hurdles.
- 23 By making these adjustments, SB 2244 can better serve all families while
- maintaining a clear and effective framework for parental engagement in
- 25 education.
