5	SECTION 1. A new subsection to section 50-25.1-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is
6	created and enacted as follows:
7	The department shall determine the military status of anany individual subject to an
8	assessment, within a reasonable amount of time, if the individual's child is the
9	subjectat the initiation of ana child abuse or neglect allegation assessment. If the
10	department determines an allegation of abuse or neglect involves a military-affiliated
11	individual, the department shall notify the nearest military installation's family advocacy
12	program of the allegation and investigation. The military installation is responsible for
13	reporting data to the federal department of defense. The department may develop a
14	memorandum of understanding for use by the human service zone. For purposes of
15	this subsection:
16	a. "Military affiliated individual" means an individual with an active military status
17	and the individual's dependents.
18	b. "Military status" includes any branch of the United States military, and the
19	national guard or reserve.
