7	<u>1.</u>	For purposes of this section, "conversion therapy" means any treatment with the goal
8		of changing the sexual orientation or gender identity of an individual. The term
9		includes medication, psychotherapy, electroshock therapy, and aversion therapy
10	2.	It is an ethical violation for a licensee to conduct conversion therapy
11	3.	It is not an ethical violation for a licensee to offer an individual questioning the
12		individual's sexuality or gender a treatment plan or counseling plan that aligns with
13		heterosexuality or the individual's biological sexlicensed clinical social worker to
14		counsel an individual who is questioning their sexuality or gender and wants to align
15		their sexuality or gender with the individual's personal or spiritual beliefs.
16	2.4.	As a condition of engaging in practices or treatment under this section, a licensee:
17		a. Shall ensure the practice or treatment is in alignment with the individual's self-
