This proposed bill provides incredible opportunities for rural North Dakota. Having been raised on a farm in North Dakota back in the 70's and 80's, I can remember some of the challenges we had back then with farming and local communities.

This bill provides an avenue for rural communities to work on essential services, help improve quality of life, and help address the housing shortage in our rural communities.
