- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 44-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the opportunity to provide public comment at a meeting of a public
- 3 entity.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 44-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
- 6 and enacted as follows:

7 Public comment - Regular meetings of political subdivisions.

- 8 <u>1.</u> <u>At least one-fourth of the publicly noticed</u>Every regular meetingsmeeting of a political
- 9 <u>subdivision</u> governing body of a city, county, township, school district,
- 10 <u>park district</u>, or water resource district held per year must include an
- 11 <u>opportunity for an individual in attendance</u> to provide public comment.
- 12 <u>2.</u> <u>An individual providing comment at a meeting shall provide to the political subdivision</u>
- 13 <u>governing body in writing the individual's name and address. The individual's address is</u>
- 14 <u>an exempt record.</u>

- 15 <u>3.</u> <u>A political subdivision</u> governing body of a city, county, township, school district, park
- 16 <u>district, or water resource district may:</u>
- 17 <u>a.</u> Limit a public comment by time per speaker, total time for public comment, or
 18 <u>both.</u>
- 19b.Develop a policy regarding public comment rules for regular meetings. The policy17may provide a public comment:
 - (1) Must be pertinent to the political subdivision.
- 19 (2) May not interfere with the orderly conduct of the regular meeting.

20 (3) <u>May not be defamatory, abusive, harassing, or unlawful.</u>
21 (4) <u>May be prohibited if an alternative procedure exists to bring that particular</u>
22 type of public comment before the political subdivision, the public comment
23 includes confidential or exempt information, or the public comment is otherwise
24 prohibited by law.
