

ONE-TIME FUNDING REQUESTS

The chart below details the one-time funding requests submitted by the North Dakota Parks & Recreation Department.

Please note that the WiFi Expansion and Park Automation initiatives have been consolidated under State Park Technology, while the County, City, and Tribal Grants and the Outdoor Fine Arts Venue Improvement Grant have been merged into Park Grants.
