HB1600 Testimony Brian Pappas Dean & Professor of Law University of North Dakota School of Law

Chair Beard and Members of the Senate Education Committee:

My name is Brian Pappas and I serve as Dean of the University of North Dakota School of Law. I write in support of HB 1600.

- Attorney fees for immigration matters often cost \$15,000-20,000. Providing services at low/no cost will be beneficial for North Dakota employers who are struggling to find workers.
- The clinic will be supporting legal immigration with the purpose of supporting businesses who are unable to hire employees in areas of need.
- We have a great need for immigration attorneys in North Dakota, with only one or two practicing in the entire state. As a result, this clinic would not take business away from any practicing attorneys.
- An immigration clinic will build capacity by training future lawyers to handle immigration matters. This clinic could train 5-20 students per year with the skills they need to provide much needed services once they become lawyers.
- While the law school has multiple clinical opportunities, we do not have funding to either hire an additional clinician or to operate this clinic.
