- 4 Thank you for the opportunity to provide testimony on HB 1168. The schools I
- 5 **represent support this bill**.
- 6 I am testifying today in strong support of HB 1168 because it is the only bill that
- 7 comprehensively addresses the complexities of school funding while ensuring
- 8 equitable property tax relief across all types of property.
- 9 As we all recognize, school funding is deeply interconnected with property taxes,
- 10 making reform a delicate yet necessary task. HB 1168 is unique in its approach,
- 11 as it acknowledges the intricate nature of taxation while providing a structured
- 12 and balanced solution. The bill ensures fairness across residential, commercial,
- and agricultural properties, preventing disproportionate burdens on any one

- sustainable tax structure that meets the needs of our schools without
- 23 overburdening property owners.
