

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1460

Page 2, lines 6 through 17:

SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 50-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

Adult foster care providers - Temporary assistants - Permitted use of electronic device for monitoring.

An adult foster care provider may:

1. Employ a temporary assistant as needed to assist with private pay adult residents that have physical limitations that require more than one provider to properly assist.
2. Use an electronic device consisting of a one-way radio ~~or video transmitter~~ with a portable receiver for monitoring an otherwise unattended adult resident within a limited range, which allows the provider to remain nearby while ensuring the safety of the resident. The use of the device must be approved in writing by the resident or, if incapacitated, the resident and resident's family or resident and legal representative before implementation.
