TESTIMONY OF MARY KAE KELSCH OFFICE OF ATTORNEY GENERAL HOUSE BILL NO. 1317

Mr. Chairman, members of the Committee.

I am Mary Kae Kelsch, Assistant Attorney General, and I appear on behalf of the Attorney General. I am the director of the General Counsel Division of the Attorney General's office. My division represents state agencies, boards, and commissions. We do not have a position on this bill but offer a simple amendment.

This bill adds two additional members to the barber board. The bill lists three tasks these members will help with: shop inspections, legal advice, and office duties. The proposed amendment takes out subsection b. Legal advice. The reason for this is that the Board of Barber Examiners has an Assistant Attorney General assigned to them who can provide legal advice. If the Board wanted to hire a different attorney to represent them, they could do so, but that attorney would have to be appointed as a Special Assistant Attorney General. Without the appointment, an attorney is not able to provide legal advice to a state board.

- 2 Century Code, relating to restricted, temporary, and retired barber licenses; to amend and

4. Anyone who becomes a member of the armed forces of the United States in time of war, while holding a license as a barber or apprentice, and while in good standing as to payment of fees, may obtain a certificate restoration without payment of the restoration fee.
