ABSTRACTS OF JUSTICES' JUDGMENTS.

AN ACT to Amend Section 5498, Revised Codes of 1899, Relating to the Filing of Abstracts of Justices' Judgments in the Office of the Clerk of the District Court and Prescribing the Effect Thereof.

Be it Enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of North Dakota:

§ 1. AMENDMENT.] That section 5498 of the revised codes of 1899 be amended to read as follows:

§ 5498. JUSTICE MUST GIVE ABSTRACT. DUTY OF CLERK OF COURT.] A justice of the peace, on the demand of a party in whose favor he shall have rendered a judgment, must give a certified abstract thereof in substantially the form prescribed by section 6717 of the justice' code, which may be filed in the office of the clerk of the district court of the county or subdivision in which the judgment was rendered, and such clerk must thereupon enter such judgment in the judgment book and upon the judgment docket; and from the time of the docketing thereof it becomes a judgment of such district court, for purposes of execution, and a lien upon real property owned by the debtor, and a certified transcript of the docket of such judgment may be filed, and the judgment docketed accordingly, in any other county or subdivision with the like effect in every respect as if the judgment had been rendered in the district court where such judgment is filed.
