All Acts and parts of Acts that may be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and if for any reason or cause any specific appropriation for any item or set of items should be held by this court or courts to be unconstitutional or illegal or otherwise unavailable for any cause, such holding shall not affect or be construed to apply to the remaining items of appropriation herein or purposes provided for herein.

SECTION 4. STATE AUDITOR'S OFFICE.) The state auditor shall contract and pay for all audits conducted by private auditing firms of state agencies, departments, and institutions. Such agencies, departments, and institutions shall reimburse the state auditor for costs incurred by his office in providing for such audits.

HOUSE BILL NO. 1002 (Committee on Appropriations)

LEGISLATIVE BRANCH

AN ACT to appropriate money for the expenses of the legislative branch of government, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION FOR THE LEGISLATIVE DEPARTMENT OF STATE GOVERNMENT.) There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund in the state treasury to the legislative branch of the state government, not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose specified, such sums as set forth in the following sections of this bill.

SECTION 2. THE PERIOD DURING WHICH APPROPRIATIONS MADE HEREIN SHALL BE AVAILABLE.) Unless otherwise specifically stated, the appropriations herein made shall be available for the expenses to be incurred in and about several purposes herein set out, during the fiscal period of two years beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 1975, to wit:

WATER CONSERVATION COMMISSION

AN ACT to appropriate money for defraying expenses of the state water conservation commission.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.) The sums hereinafter named only, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of the general fund and from special funds derived from federal funds and/or other income in the state treasury to the various departments and various divisions thereof of the state of North Dakota for the biennium beginning July 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1975, for defraying expenses of the state water conservation commission.

HERITAGE CENTER

AN ACT making an appropriation for the construction of a Heritage Center.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.) There is hereby appropriated to the North Dakota heritage commission the sum of \$500,000 or so much thereof as necessary from the general fund in the state treasury and \$1,500,000, or such greater amount as may become available in federal grants, donations, contributions, or other sources not appropriated from state general or special funds toward the construction of a heritage center on the state capitol grounds.

SECTION 2.) The heritage commission may invest amounts received pursuant to the appropriation from the general fund in certificates of deposit in the Bank of North Dakota. Such amounts and interest earned on such amounts shall not become available for construction of the heritage center unless the heritage commission has certified that not less than \$1,500,000 in contributions, donations, federal grants, or other sources not appropriated from state general or special funds is available.

HOUSE BILL NO. 1131 (Hildebrand, L. Hausauer, Solberg)

NATIONAL GUARD RECRUITING

AN ACT providing an appropriation to the national guard for recruiting and strength maintenance purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.) There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$45,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the North Dakota national guard for the biennium beginning July 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1975, for the purpose of recruiting and strength maintenance. Such recruiting and strength maintenance activities may include, but shall not be limited to, the provision to members of the national guard of suitable awards, honorariums, or other proper recognition for successful recruiting efforts; the provision of subsistence rations at official national guard functions designed to provide information in regard to and create interest in the national guard among potential recruits and their families; the preparation of informational material in regard to the national guard; the provision of advertising for recruiting purposes; and other necessary expenses in regard thereto.

Approved March 6, 1973

HOUSE BILL NO. 1150 (Lundene, Streibel, Backes, H. Johnson, Haugland, Strinden)

BLUE BOOK

AN ACT making an appropriation to provide for the preparation, printing, and distribution of the North Dakota blue book.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1.) The secretary of state shall print, furnish, and distribute the North Dakota blue book as follows:

1. One copy to each member of the legislative assembly; 2. Two copies to the state historical society; Two copies to the state law library; 3. 4. Two copies to the university; 5. Two copies to the state university; 6. Five copies to the legislative council; 7. One copy to each public institution maintained by the state; 8. One copy to each elective and appointive state officer; 9. One copy to each public library in the state; 10. One copy to each county auditor; 11. One copy to each high school in the state; 12. One copy to each supreme court justice; and One copy to each district judge. 13.

The North Dakota blue book shall not contain more than five hundred pages and the number to be printed shall not exceed two thousand volumes. The secretary of state may sell the remaining copies of the book to individuals at cost, and the proceeds of such sales shall be deposited in the general fund. The printing and binding of the North Dakota blue book shall be let as a special class of printing upon competitive bidding to the lowest bidder.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.) There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$20,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the secretary of state for the preparation, printing, and distribution of the North Dakota blue book, for the period beginning upon the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 1975.

HOUSE BILL NO. 1178 (K. Johnson, Olin, Gengler, Murphy, Rundle)

CHATEAU DE MORES INTERPRETIVE CENTER

AN ACT making an appropriation for the completion of an interpretive center at the Chateau de Mores, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.) There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$24,542.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the state historical board for the purpose of completing an interpretive center at the Chateau de Mores for the biennium beginning July 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1975.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.) This Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

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HOUSE BILL NO. 1204 (Atkinson, Martinson)

STATE OFFICERS' EXPENSE PAYMENTS

AN ACT to provide payment of expenses to certain elected state officers, providing for an appropriation, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. ELECTED OFFICIALS' EXPENSE PAYMENTS.) In order to properly discharge their official duties, the following elected state officials shall be paid the sum set forth opposite their respective titles for each of the calendar years of 1973 and 1974:

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION.) There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$242,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary, to carry out the provisions of this Act.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.) This Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

Approved March 8, 1973

HOUSE BILL NO. 1419 (Committee on Appropriations)

COYOTE CONTROL

AN ACT to provide an appropriation to the department of agriculture for the control and reduction of the state's coyote population, providing a statement of legislative intent, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.) There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$6,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the department of agriculture for predatory animal control for the period beginning at the time of passage and approval of this Act and ending June 30, 1973. Such funds shall be expended for the control and reduction of the state's coyote population through the period ending June 30, 1973.

SECTION 2. INTENT.) It is the intent of the legislative assembly that the funds appropriated by this Act be expended immediately to reduce the coyote population in certain areas of the state where coyotes are committing depredations which are detrimental or a nuisance to the farmers and ranchers in those areas.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.) This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.

SENATE BILL NO. 2001 (Committee on Appropriations)

STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING

AN ACT making an appropriation for defraying expenses of the state institutions of higher learning of the state of North Dakota.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS.) There is hereby appropriated the sums herein specified, derived from institutional income and institutional collections, and derived from rent, interest, or income from land, money or property donated or granted by the United States and allocated to the institutions of higher learning under the terms of the Enabling Act and the state Constitution, and such additional unappropriated funds as specified, are hereby appropriated out of the general fund in the state treasury as may be necessary to pay the operation, maintenance, plant improvements, and general expenses of each of the institutions hereinafter named in the sums set forth as follows for the biennium beginning July 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1975, unless specifically stated otherwise.

Any additional income not required by law to be deposited in the operating fund in the state treasury and income from increased enrollments is hereby appropriated. All income resulting from increased enrollments in excess of estimated income in the budget appropriated by the legislature to the institutions of higher learning must be deposited in their operating funds in the state treasury and can be expended only by authorization of the emergency commission.

SECTION 2. NEW PROGRAMS.) The new programs requested and approved by the board of higher education for the institutions of higher learning are hereby authorized if institutional funds become available for their implementation.

SECTION 3. INTENT, REPEAL, PURPOSE AND CONSTRUCTION.) All Acts and parts of Acts that may be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and if for any reason or cause any specific appropriation for any item or set of items should be held by the court or courts to be unconstitutional or illegal or otherwise unavailable for any cause, such holdings shall not affect or be construed to apply to the remaining items of appropriation herein or purposes herein.

SECTION 4.) The board of higher education is hereby authorized to use operating funds in addition to appropriated plant improvement funds for the maintenance, repair, and improvement of buildings and land acquisition at the various institutions, with consent of the emergency commission during the biennium beginning July 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1975.

SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.) The forty-third legislative assembly hereby expresses its intent that residency programs developed and established in North Dakota in support of the 2-1-1 or any other medical education plan implemented by the state board of higher education or the university of North Dakota medical school be financed in conjunction with the private sector. The legislature considers the private sector as including, but not being limited to, area health education centers, private clinics and hospitals, federal health care facilities, grants, individual physicians and surgeons, and other health care and allied health care institutions.

SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.) It is the intent of

the Legislative Assembly that the colleges and universities pay special assessments from their plant improvement monies. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 40-23-22, no funds shall be expended to pay special assessments on projects that do not directly serve a state institution and are not located on or contiguous to a state institution, wherever located in the state.

SECTION 7. NORTH DAKOTA STATE UNIVERSITY.) In addition to the appropriations and authorizations provided by this Act, there is hereby appropriated \$313,202 for the North Dakota State University from the general fund in the state treasury during the biennium beginning July 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1975, to be used only in the event of a reduction, and only to the extent of such reduction, in either or both years of the biennium in the receipt of federal funds by the North Dakota State University pursuant to the Bankhead-Jones Act. Such reduction during each year of the biennium shall be determined by subtracting the amounts received under the Bankhead-Jones Act each year from the amounts received during the fiscal year ended June 30, 1972. Funds shall be made available pursuant to this contingency appropriation only upon approval of the state board of higher education and with written notification by such board to the director of accounts and purchases.

APPROPRIATIONS

Any additional income including funds from the federal government and gifts and donations from private sources received by the North Dakota main experiment station, branch stations, and the cooperative extension division, except as otherwise provided by law, are hereby appropriated for the purpose designated in the gift, grant, or donation; however, public moneys from local sources, which shall include receipts from sale of grains, personal services, dairy products, livestock, and other agricultural products at the North Dakota main experiment station, branch experiment stations and the cooperative extension division, may be expended in excess of that specifically appropriated through biennial appropriations bills of the legislative assembly only in the event that an authorization has first been received from the subcommittee on budget of the legislative council. The balances of all existing moneys on deposit in the name of the North Dakota state university main experiment station, the branch experiment stations, and the cooperative extension division, except grants, gifts, and donations from private sources, along with all subsequent receipts of such moneys, shall be deposited in a special fund in the state treasury. Hereafter, this fund shall be referred to as an operating fund and shall also be the depository for transfers from the general fund, and balances therein shall not revert to any other fund under the terms of section 54-44.1-11. All of the moneys in the operating fund shall remain in such fund until expended pursuant to a specific legislative appropriation or an authorization from the subcommittee on budget of the legislative council, and the balances of such moneys except those received from the federal government or as gifts from private sources, shall be used to reduce the amount of moneys to be expended pursuant to the general fund appropriation only to the extent that the unencumbered balance in the operating fund on June 30, 1973, exceeds the estimated income for the biennium ending June 30, 1975. The state board of higher education is authorized to approve transfer of funds between categories of expenditures, and will notify the director of the department of accounts and purchases of any such transfers within ten days following such authorization.

SECTION 2. INTENT, REPEAL, PURPOSE AND CONSTRUCTION.) All Acts and parts of Acts that may be in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and if for any reason or cause any specific appropriation for any item or set of items should be held by the court or courts to be unconstitutional or illegal or otherwise unavailable for any cause, such holdings shall not affect or be construed to apply to the remaining items of appropriation herein or purposes herein.

SECTION 3. PLANT IMPROVEMENTS.) Minor structures for agricultural research may be authorized for construction by the state board of higher education when such structures do not exceed \$20,000 in cost.

SECTION 4. MAIN EXPERIMENT STATION.) In addition to the appropriations and authorizations provided by this Act, there is hereby appropriated \$150,000 for the Main Experiment Station from the general fund in the state treasury during the biennium beginning July 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1975, to be used only in the event of a reduction, and only to the extent of such reduction, in either or both years of the biennium in the receipt of federal funds by the Experiment Station pursuant to the Hatch Act. Such reduction during each year of the biennium shall be determined by subtracting the amounts under the Hatch Act each year from the amounts received during the fiscal year ended June 30, 1973. Funds shall be made available pursuant to this contingency appropriation only upon approval of the state board of higher education and with written notification by such board to the director of accounts and purchases.

SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT.) It is the intent of the Legislative Assembly that the special programs in the Extension Division, known as Special Program - Nutritional, ABM Impact Area Development, and Man Power Project, which are totally federally funded shall not be continued when federal funds are no longer forth coming.

There is hereby appropriated to the social service board, out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, the sum of \$69,012.00 and the sum of \$207,065.00 in federal funds or such lesser amounts as may be necessary, not otherwise appropriated, to employ a certified public accountant, establish five screening teams, and develop a fiscal planning and program monitoring system during the biennium beginning July 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1975. The social service board shall establish during this period of time and implement a system for paying vendors of medical services on a basis related to the level of care and treatment provided eligible recipients, and shall from time to time report the status of its work to the legislative council or such committee of the council as it designates.

SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION.) There is hereby appropriated to the social service board the sum of \$1,000,000.00 in federal funds and \$400,000.00 to be contributed by individuals, organizations, governmental units, or other sources, or such lesser amounts as may be necessary, for purposes determined to be eligible for funding as provided by state and federal law during the biennium beginning July 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1975. SECTION 5. LABORATORIES COMMISSION MAY ISSUE BONDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A BUILDING - PAYMENT OF BONDS - APPROPRIATION.)

For the purpose of paying the cost of construction of 1. a building to house the state laboratories department, the state laboratories commission may borrow money on the credit of the revenue to be derived from fees collected by the department pursuant to law. In anticipation of such collections, the commission may issue negotiable bonds in a total amount not to exceed \$750,000, and may provide for the payment of those bonds and the rights of holders thereof, provided that bonds issued under this section shall not be an indebtedness of the state of North Dakota. Bonds issued under this section shall be payable serially, and may be issued in one or more series, may bear such date or dates, may mature at such times but not later than ten years from the date of issuance of the first series, may be in such denomination or denominations, may be in such form either coupon or registered, may carry such registration and conversion privileges, may be executed in such manner, may be payable in such medium of payment at such place or places, may be subject to such

terms of redemption with or without premium, and may bear such rate or rates of interest as may be provided by resolution of the commission. Bonds issued under this section shall have all of the qualities and incidents of negotiable paper, and shall not be subject to taxation by the state of North Dakota, or by any county, municipality, or other political subdivision thereof. Bonds issued under this section may be purchased by the Bank of North Dakota, with approval of the industrial commission.

- 2. There is hereby created a laboratories department sinking fund in the state treasury to which shall be credited the proceeds of fees collected and appropriated by this section. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 19-01-07, so much of the proceeds from fees collected by the state laboratories department as may be necessary for payment of the principal and interest on bonds issued under this section are hereby appropriated to and shall be deposited by the laboratories commission in the laboratories department sinking fund until such time as it is determined by the industrial commission that sufficient funds exist in the sinking fund for the payment of the principal of all outstanding bonds and interest thereon.
- 3. The proceeds of any bonds issued under the authority of this section are hereby appropriated to the state laboratories commission for construction of a building to house the laboratories department. Construction and furnishing of the building shall be contracted for and supervised by the state laboratories commission or its designee.

SECTION 6. AMENDMENT.) Section 19-10-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

19-10-19. INSPECTION FEES.) Every person shipping or transporting kerosene, gasoline, tractor fuel, heating oil, or diesel fuel into this state for sale or consignment or with intent to sell or consign the same, or holding any such product for sale in this state, shall pay to the department an inspection fee of one-fortieth of a cent per gallon for each and every gallon thereof so shipped or transported into the state, or held for sale within the state. An inspection fee shall not be required for a shipment or consignment of gasoline, kerosene, tractor fuel, heating oil, or diesel fuel when the inspection fee has already been paid by another dealer. The fee shall accompany the monthly report required in the following section and shall be due on the first of each calendar month for the preceding month. Such fee shall become delinquent when ten days past due.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.) Section 6 of this Act shall not become effective until such time as the industrial commission certifies to the state laboratories department or its designee that the bonds issued pursuant to this Act have been retired.

SECTION 2.) This Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

STATE TOXICOLOGIST FOR EXAMINATION OF BLOOD SPECIMENS

- AN ACT making an appropriation for the use of the state toxicologist.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.) There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$5,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the state toxicologist for the purpose of examining blood specimens of victims of motor vehicle accidents for the biennium beginning July 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1975, as provided in section 1 of chapter 359 of the 1969 Session Laws.

SENATE BILL NO. 2158 (Lips, Melland, Hoffner)

NATIONAL GUARD AIR AMBULANCE FACILITIES

AN ACT providing for an appropriation to match federal funds available for the constructing, furnishing, and equipping of North Dakota national guard air ambulance facilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.) There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$50,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the North Dakota national guard for the purpose of matching available federal funds to defray the costs of constructing, furnishing, and equipping an army national guard helicopter air ambulance hangar and other related facilities during the biennium beginning July 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1975.

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SENATE BILL NO. 2255 (Committee on Appropriations)

ADMINISTRATION OF MOTOR FUEL TAX

- AN ACT to transfer a portion of the motor vehicle fuel tax revenues to the general fund to cover the cost of administering the motor fuel tax laws.
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. TRANSFER.) There is hereby transferred to the general fund in the state treasury out of the motor vehicle fuel taxes, collected pursuant to section 57-54-08 of the North Dakota Century Code, the sum of three hundred thirty-five thousand dollars for the purpose of reimbursing the general fund for expenses incurred in the collection of the motor vehicle fuels and special fuels taxes and the administration of the respective tax Acts.

SENATE BILL NO. 2256 (Committee on Appropriations)

PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX REPLACEMENT

AN ACT to provide an appropriation for the replacement of personal property taxes, and the distribution of such moneys.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.) There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$17,920,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the replacement of personal property taxes, in accordance with the formula for personal property tax replacement payments as provided for in section 57-58-01, during the biennium beginning July 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1975. During the year ending June 30, 1974, such payment shall not exceed one-half of the total appropriation provided for in this Act.

SECTION 2. CONTINGENT.) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 57-58-01, which contains the formula for personal property tax replacement payments, the payments shall not exceed the amounts as set forth in this Act. If the appropriation provided for in this Act in any fiscal year is less than the amount determined by applying the formula as contained in section 57-58-01, the director of the department of accounts and purchases shall pay only the amount of funds available under this Act. Under such circumstances, a method of proration shall be used that provides each eligible recipient the same proportion of these funds as the percent of total funds it would have received under the application of the formula provided for in section 57-58-01.

MERIT SYSTEM COUNCIL

AN ACT to provide an appropriation for salaries and expenses of the merit system council.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.) There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys received by the North Dakota merit system council the sum of \$164,150.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for salaries and expenses of the merit system council for the biennium beginning July 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1975, to wit:

CHAPTER 44 SENATE BILL NO. 2357

(Committee on Finance and Taxation)

PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX REPLACEMENT DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATION

AN ACT making a deficiency appropriation for personal property tax replacement for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.) There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$500,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the replacement of personal property taxes for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1973, which moneys shall be in addition to and supplemental to the appropriation provided in chapter 37 of the 1971 Session Laws of North Dakota.

SECTION 2. CONTINGENT.) If the appropriation provided for in this Act together with the unexpended balance of the appropriation provided in chapter 37 of the 1971 Session Laws of North Dakota are less than the amount due for personal property tax replacement payments for fiscal year ending June 30, 1973, as determined pursuant to the replacement formula provided in section 57-58-01 of the North Dakota Century Code, the director of the department of accounts and purchases shall calculate the amount for payment to the state medical center and to each county as follows: the total amount computed by the tax commissioner by applying the proper formula and certified by him as the total amount of payments in the fiscal year for the state medical center and each county and its political subdivisions shall be reduced proportionately by multiplying that total amount by the ratio that the amount of appropriation available for payment in the fiscal year bears to the total amount certified by the tax commissioner for payment in the fiscal year for the state medical center and the counties and their political subdivisions.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY.) This Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

SENATE BILL NO. 2413 (Lips)

BANK OF NORTH DAKOTA -PARKING IMPROVEMENTS

AN ACT making an appropriation for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Bank of North Dakota.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.) There is hereby appropriated out of any monies in the state treasury in the Bank of North Dakota fund the sum of \$150,000.00 for the purchase and improvement of adjacent property for parking, \$150,000.00 or so much thereof as may be necessary, during the biennium beginning July 1, 1973, and ending June 30, 1975.
