



Who We Are

- NDSC is authorized by USDA to collect and administer the federal soybean checkoff in North Dakota.
- The soybean checkoff is 0.5% of each bushel price collected at the first point of sale.
- 50% of the funds remain in ND for investment and 50% are submitted to the United Soybean Board.
- The board of 12 elected soybean farmers from around the state is responsible for investing the checkoff in research, communication, promotion and market development.



12 directors | **10,000** soybean farmers | **218,700,000** bushels of soybeans (2023)

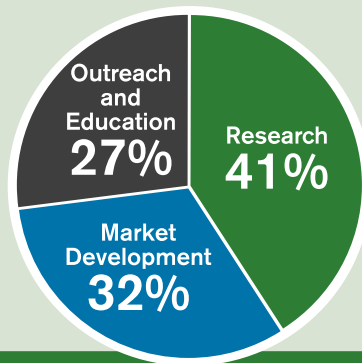

U.S. soybean farmers receive **\$12.30** in added value for every dollar invested in the checkoff.



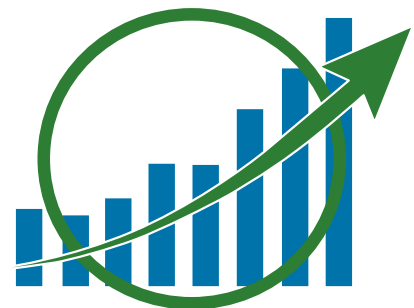
