Major Legislation Affecting the School for the Blind

House Bill No. 1038 - This bill changes the name of the North Dakota School for the Blind to North Dakota Vision Services - School for the Blind and expands the responsibilities of the agency to provide that it is a statewide service, resource, and referral center for all residents of the state who are blind or visually impaired.
