House Bill No. 1419 - Legislative Council - House Action

This bill appropriates \$150,000 from the workers' compensation fund to the Legislative Council for conducting a study of workers' compensation insurance, including contracting with an industry expert to conduct an independent study of the effects of competition on workers' compensation premiums, anticipated impacts on rates, services provided to injured workers, and coverage for employers.
