



Major Related Legislation

House Bill No. 1015 - State Radio Communications - This bill transfers State Radio Communications from the Office of Management and Budget to the Division of Emergency Management.

House Bill No. 1024 - Deficiency appropriation - This bill provides the Division of Emergency Management a deficiency appropriation of \$6,385,000 for the 2003-05 biennium for interagency suppression and support costs incurred on state land related to the Magpie Camp, Whitetail, and Deep Creek fires (\$110,000) and repayment of the loan from the Bank of North Dakota for the state's share of disaster costs (\$6,275,000).
