



Major Related Legislation

House Bill No. 1127 provides that an applicant for a moneybroker license must pay an additional annual fee of \$50 for each branch location within the state and the Department of Financial Institutions may charge an additional \$50 fee for a delinquent license renewal.

House Bill No. 1174 provides for the licensing, reports, and examination of money transmitters and provides an appropriation from the financial institutions regulatory fund to the Department of Financial Institutions for \$193,742 for the licensing and regulation of money transmitters.
