**Senate Bill No. 2145 - Parks and Recreation Department - Senate Action**

This bill provides a \$3,524,030 special funds appropriation consisting of \$522,520 from the Game and Fish fund, \$2,476,760 from profits of the Bank of North Dakota, and \$524,720 from federal or other special funds to the Parks and Recreation Department for the purchase of land in western North Dakota.
