House Bill No. 1460 - Department of Human Services - House Action

This bill provides a \$100,000 appropriation, of which \$50,000 is from the general fund and \$50,000 is from special funds, to the Department of Human Services for obtaining actuarial service for developing actuarially based methodologies for setting medical assistance payment rates and developing department budget recommendations, performing and reviewing data analyses, tracking program service utilization, and determining the effectiveness of quality and cost-containment initiatives in the medical assistance program.

House Bill No. 1460 - Department of Human Services - Senate Action
